Part-time teacher of circus disciplines Mainly aerial disciplines - versatile appreciated

The École de cirque de Québec is currently seeking teachers of aerial disciplines for the advanced training program (DEC-DEE, as well as Cirque-Études Secondaires) for the 2024-25 year.

We're looking for teachers who can teach several aerial circus disciplines, but knowledge of other disciplines is also desirable, such as juggling, floor acrobatics, trampoline, handstand, acrobatic bicycle, hula-hoop, Cyr wheel, fabric, corde lisse and aerial hoop. Teaching could be in small groups or in the context of individual classes in these professionalization programs.

Main tasks:

- Plan courses according to objectives
- Support each student in his or her training process
- Evaluate the achievement of objectives at each session and communicate with students to promote their autonomy and development.
- Collaborate with various stakeholders in the higher education sector

Requirements

- In-depth knowledge of the various techniques and exercises leading to professional mastery of disciplines
- Ability to communicate and collaborate
- Teaching experience
- Fluency in spoken and written French. Knowledge of English is an asset.
- Canadian citizenship, permanent residency or work permit
- NCCP, ACS or circus teaching certification an asset

Working conditions :

- Fall 2024 session: August 23 to December 3, 2024
- Winter 2025 session: January 6 to April 14, 2025
- Possibility of extension for end-of-year shows and summer courses (end of July 2025). (Possibility of working almost annually, depending on skills and disciplines taught).
